

## **Crews prepping to pave Orange Avenue to Magnolia Avenue**

**Underground utilities installed on north end near ISB**

Crews are preparing the road base to be paved on Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. (MLK) between Orange Avenue and Magnolia Avenue. This week, crews are scheduled to begin paving this section of the roadway. Once work begins, it is estimated it will take one to two days to pave, and then this portion of MLK will be reopened to local traffic. Quick Tire is accessible from Eldorado Street, and Devores House of Beauty is accessible from Orange Avenue. Beauty shop customers can park across the street in the convenience store parking lot.



Crews have finished installing underground utilities from Magnolia Avenue to International Speedway Boulevard (ISB). This week crews are starting to install curbing on the east side of the roadway. Ahyan Food Mart customers should use Foote Court off of Marion Street. Checker's and Buck's Gun Rack are accessible from ISB.

The MLK and Magnolia Avenue intersection is closed to allow the finished underground utilities to be tied into the main systems, which will take about four weeks to complete. Customers can still access the Quick Stop Car Wash and other area businesses on the east side of the MLK and Magnolia Avenue intersection. Motorists can use Marion Street or Lincoln Street to get to Magnolia Avenue and access the businesses.

Customers can park temporarily in the right-of-way on the side streets to access the businesses. Pedestrians should not walk through the work area. If walking around the work site perimeter, pedestrians are urged to use caution.
