

11 The following items were taken from her daughter's bedroom; all of her clothing and shoes (valued at \$300), a 35" flat screen TV (valued at \$700),  
 12 a PS3 gaming system (valued at \$300), two gaming controllers (valued at \$110 total), 7 misc. games (valued at \$280 total), a complete  
 13 professional nail technician kit (valued at \$150), and a BOSE Bluetooth speaker (valued at \$135).  
 14  
 15 The following items were missing from her master bedroom; three pairs of new shoes (values at \$200 total), family heirloom pearl earrings (valued  
 16 at \$350), four pairs of sterling silver earrings (valued at \$175 total), a gold cross with an opal stone (valued at \$300), two gold bracelets (valued at  
 17 \$400 total), gold and diamond tennis bracelet (values at \$250), approximately 20 pieces of misc. costume jewelry (valued at \$400 total), a DVD  
 18 player (valued at \$50), a 48" flat screen Visio TV (valued at \$600), two hair dryers (valued at \$50 total), two curling irons (valued at \$50 total), hair  
 19 trimmers (valued at \$40), hair clippers (valued at \$30), laptop (valued at \$300), and her entire Mary Kay inventory (valued at \$1700 total).  
 20  
 21 The following items were missing from her dining room/ office area; 19" fat screen TV (valued at \$200), rechargeable battery tool set which  
 22 included a circular saw, drill, and a flashlight (the set is valued at \$350), misc. tools (a work bucket, a hammer, scrappers, utility knives, and  
 23 extension cords) valued at \$100.  
 24  
 25 The following items were missing from her kitchen; \$30 worth of misc. food items, misc. liquor (valued at \$65), a case of Arizona energy drink  
 26 (valued at \$24), case of smart water (valued at \$15), case of citrus tea (valued at \$15), and two gallons of paint (valued at \$40).  
 27  
 28 An eight foot ladder was missing from her backyard (valued at \$165).  
 29  
 30 The above items totaled in the amount of approximately \$9,493.  
 31  
 32 Officer Knight recovered two latent prints from the front screen door and four inside the rear patio. I recovered two latent prints from the daughter's  
 33 window sill. Officer Knight electronically submitted nine digital photographs into evidence. See Officer Knights supplement for additional  
 34 information.  
 35  
 36 It was determined that the point of entry was made through the second story window in the daughter's bedroom. There were several fresh pry  
 37 marks on the screen and the frame of the window.  
 38  
 39 [REDACTED]  
 40 [REDACTED] The sliding glass door led to the porch. The surveillance  
 41 clarity is very good. The surveillance captured that the subjects entered the victim's residence four separate times; the first time was on 6/24/2016  
 42 at approximately 0806 hours, the second time was on 6/24/2016 at approximately 1322 hours, the third time was on 6/25/2016 at approximately  
 43 0633 hours, and the fourth time on 6/25/2016 at approximately 0949 hours.  
 44  
 45 The first entry by the subject displays a white female wearing a light colored t-shirt with light colored hair and a light pair of jeans. The female  
 46 appears to be rummaging through several storage containers throughout the living room area.  
 47  
 48 The second entry displays the same subject wearing a black and white spotted tank top, jean shorts, a black head band, and a tattoo on her left  
 49 hip. This time the subject was carrying a green and pink bag, continuing to rummage through the containers.  
 50  
 51 The third entry displays the same subject with her hair in a bun, a sleeveless white shirt, and capri pants. In this entry at approximately 0635 hours  
 52 the surveillance displays the female subject removing the living room TV from the entertainment stand.  
 53  
 54 The fourth entry displays the subject entering through the rear sliding glass door. At 0950 hours the subject is observed escorting a tall dark  
 55 skinned black male towards the rear sliding glass door. Unfortunately the male was facing away from the camera; however, he was carrying a  
 56 large flat screen TV outside onto the porch.  
 57  
 58 The Victim was unable to place the video surveillance onto a thumb drive at the time of my investigation; however, she advised that when she is  
 59 able to do so she will submit it as evidence at the front desk of 129 Valor Blvd. along with any serial numbers. The victim advised that she does  
 60 wish to press charges and completed a sworn statement.  
 61  
 62 While the victim was completing her statement I canvassed the area for any additional evidence, at which point I discovered the following; a  
 63 paperback book on the roof near the daughter's window, a large blue luggage bag underneath the porch, a package of opened sausage behind  
 64 the victims shield, and the location where the items were possibly loaded from.  
 65  
 66 Once the blue luggage bag was photographed the victim looked through it and discovered the following items were inside; several her daughter's  
 67 clothing items, misc. toiletry items, and misc. costume jewelry.

 70 marks which ultimately led me to a wheel barrel. The wheel barrel was located on the north side of Lexington Dr. along the vacant lot. The victim
