1 ON THE AFOREMENTIONED DATE I RESPONDED TO 14 CARDINAL ESTATES REFERENCE A PURPORTED DOMESTIC BATTERY. UPON
 2 ARRIVAL I CAME INTO CONTACT WITH V-1. V-1 INFORMED ME THAT HER HUSBAND OF SIX MONTHS (THE DEFENDANT) WHOM SHE
 3 HAS LIVED WITH AS A FAMILY UNIT FOR THE DURATION OF THE MARRIAGE STRUCK HER MULTIPLE TIMES IN AND AROUND HER
 4 FACE WITH A CLOSED FIST. V-1 STATES THE DEFENDANT ALSO "CHOKED" HER WITH HIS HANDS AT WHICH TIME SHE WAS UNABLE
 5 TO BREATHE THEREFORE PREVENTING THE FLOW OF BOTH BLOOD AND OXYGEN TO HER BRAIN TEMPORARILY. V-1 RELAYED THE
 6 FOLLOWING DETAILED STORY TO ME WHILST ON SCENE;
 7 V-1 WAS IN THE PASSENGER SEAT OF HER VEHICLE (VEH-1), THE DEFENDANT WAS DRIVING THE VEHICLE. BOTH PARTIES HAD
 8 JUST LEFT THE VOLUSIA MALL AND WERE SOMEWHERE IN THE VICINITY OF THE 200 TO 400 BLOCK OF COLFAX AVENUE WHEN
 9 THEY BEGAN ARGUING. V-1 STATES THE DEFENDANT THREATENED TO THROW HER OUT OF THE CAR WHILE DRIVING AND
 10 PROCEEDED TO STRIKE HER IN AND AROUND HER FACE MULTIPLE TIMES WITH A CLOSED FIST. UPON REACHING THE GENERAL

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11 AREA OF THE 00 BLOCK OF CARDINAL ESTATES THE DEFENDANT REACHED OVER AND BEGAN CHOKING V-1. V-1 RELAYED SHE
 12 WAS HAVING TO "GASP" TO OBTAIN A BREATH AS HE HAD RESTRICTED/STOPPED HER BREATHING, IN TURN CAUSING THE
 13 SLOWING/STOPPING OF BLOOD AND OXYGEN FLOW TO HER BRAIN. V-1 STATES THE DEFENDANT TOOK THE NECKLACE FROM HER
 14 NECK AND HER WALLET AND ONCE V-1 EXITED THE VEHICLE FLED THE AREA WITH HER CAR (VEHICLE-1) 2015 RED IN COLOR
 15 CHEVROLET SONIC BEARING "MIAMI HEAT" SPECIALTY TAG-L69UJ. V-1 SHOWED SOME DISCOLORATION AND BRUISING TO THE
 16 FACE AND NECK AREA. V-1 REFUSED TO BE SEEN BY MEDICAL STAFF. V-1 WAS ADVISED OF THE AVAILABILITY OF A DOMESTIC
 17 VIOLENCE SHELTER, HOWEVER DECLINED SHELTER. V-1 WAS PROVIDED WITH AND RECEIVED/SIGNED FOR ALL DOMESTIC
 18 VIOLENCE PAPERWORK AND INFORMATION. V-1 COMPLETED A SWORN WRITTEN STATEMENT EXPRESSING A DESIRE TO SEEK
 19 PROSECUTION. WHILST CALLING FOR A BACK-UP UNIT TO BRING ME A DIGITAL CAMERA TO DOCUMENT V-1'S INJURIES, OFFICER T.
 20 JACKSON LOCATED A RED IN COLOR 2015 CHEVROLET SONIC BEARING "MIAMI HEAT" TAG-L69UJ AND RECOGNIZED IT TO BE
 21 VEHICLE-1, TRAVELING NORTH AT THE INTERSECTION OF MASON AND CLYDE MORRIS BLVD. OFFICER JACKSON ACTIVATED HIS
 22 EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT (INCLUDING RED/BLUE LIGHTS AND AUDIBLE SIREN) ON HIS DEPARTMENT ISSUED, FULLY MARKED
 23 PATROL UNIT (UNIT 5267) WHICH BEARS ALL AGENCY INSIGNIA AT THE INTERSECTION OF JIMMY ANN AND CLYDE MORRIS BLVD.
 24 THE DEFENDANT ACCELERATED RAPIDLY AWAY FROM OFFICER JACKSON AND PROCEEDED TO TURN NORTH BOUND ON JIMMY
 25 ANN FLEEING OFFICER JACKSON'S ATTEMPTED DETENTION. THE DEFENDANT CONTINUED TO FLEE FROM OFFICER JACKSON
 26 NORTH BOUND ON JIMMY ANN ACCELERATING TO AN EXTREMELY HIGH RATE OF SPEED. AT THIS POINT I WAS TRAVELING SOUTH
 27 ON JIMMY ANN AND OBSERVED THE VEHICLE CONTINUING TO FLEE NORTH AT ONE POINT PASSING ME. I WOULD LATER IDENTIFY
 28 THE INDIVIDUAL I HAD SEEN IN ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL OF THE VEHICLE (DRIVING THE VEHICLE) AS THE DEFENDANT. THIS
 29 IDENTIFICATION WAS DONE VIA REVIEWING A J-PIX (VOLUSIA COUNTY JAIL IMAGING PROGRAM) PHOTO. THE DEFENDANT
 30 SUBSEQUENTLY TURNED INTO CARDINAL ESTATES. AS THIS SUBDIVISION IS A CLOSED OFF AREA MULTIPLE UNITS RESPONDED
 31 TO THE AREA IN AN ATTEMPT TO EITHER RELOCATE THE DEFENDANT OR VEHICLE-1. PER AN ACTIVE WARRANT THE DEFENDANT
 32 HAS AN ADDRESS OF 29 STARLING DR. I RESPONDED TO THE ADDRESS WITH OFFICER T. JACKSON WHERE WE LOCATED
 33 VEHICLE-1 UNOCCUPIED WITH THE KEYS ON THE SEAT IN THE BACKYARD OF THE HOME. THE DEFENDANT HAD PRESUMABLY
 34 FLED THE AREA ON FOOT. PER AN OCCUPANT OF A NEIGHBORING HOME A MALE MATCHING THE DEFENDANT'S DESCRIPTION
 35 WAS SEEN RUNNING INTO THE WOODS IN A SOUTHERN DIRECTION FROM 31 STARLING DR.

 37 MULTIPLE UNITS ASSISTED BY SETTING UP A PERIMETER TO ASSIST IN THE LOCATION AND DETENTION OF THE DEFENDANT.
 38 VOLUSIA COUNTY K-9, VOLUSIA COUNTY HELICOPTER (AIR-1), AS WELL AS APPROXIMATELY A DOZEN LAW ENFORCEMENT
 39 UNITS/OFFICERS WERE BROUGHT INTO THE AREA TO ATTEMPT TO LOCATE THE DEFENDANT.

 41 CONTACT WAS LATER MADE WITH VICTIM-1 AGAIN AT WHICH TIME HER VEHICLE WAS RETURNED TO HER AND DIGITAL PHOTOS
 42 DOCUMENTING HER INJURIES WERE RECOVERED AND SUBSEQUENTLY DIGITALLY TAGGED AT DBPD PROPERTY/EVIDENCE BY
 43 OFFICER S. CATALANO. PRIOR TO RETURNING VEHICLE-1 TO V-1 MYSELF AND OFFICER T. JACKSON CONDUCTED A SEARCH OF
 44 THE VEHICLE RECOVERING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS OF EVIDENTIARY VALUE;

 46 (1) SILVER IN COLOR DIGITAL SCALE WITH WHITE POWDERY RESIDUE IN THE DRIVERS SIDE DOOR. THIS WHITE POWDERY
 47 RESIDUE WAS TESTED WITH A SIRCHIE TEST KIT YIELDING A PRESUMPTIVE REACTION FOR THE PRESENCE OF COCAINE.
 48 (1) SILVER/WHITE/GREEN CYLINDER DISPLAYING THE WORD "GRINDER" IN THE UPPER GLOVE BOX. THIS ITEM IS COMMONLY
 49 UTILIZED TO GRIND CANNABIS BUD FOR SMOKING PURPOSES. THIS CYLINDER CONTAINED A TRACE AMOUNT OF A GREEN LEAFY
 50 SUBSTANCE I IMMEDIATELY RECOGNIZED (THROUGH BOTH TRAINING AND PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE) TO BE SUSPECTED CANNABIS.
 51 THIS TRACE AMOUNT WAS TESTED WITH A NARC FIELD TEST KIT YIELDING A PRESUMPTIVE RESULT FOR THE PRESENCE OF
 52 CANNABIS.
 53 BOTH ITEMS WERE SHOWN TO V-1 WHO DENIED EVER OWNING AND/OR BEING AWARE OF THESE ITEMS. IT SHOULD BE NOTED
 54 THE ONLY INDIVIDUAL THAT HAD OCCUPIED VEH-1, OTHER THAN THE VICTIM WAS THE DEFENDANT.

 56 PER A TELETYPE REQUEST OF THE DEFENDANT'S INFORMATION IT WAS REVEALED THAT THE DEFENDANT'S LICENSE IS
