

Magnolia Avenue reopened; crews working Saturday

Updates :

Crews will be working from **7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 9**, on the new water main from Cherry Street to Orange Avenue. There are no new detours associated with this work; however, motorists should use caution when driving in this area. Crews are expediting the work schedule by overlapping, where possible, certain work elements of Phase I and Phase II of this project.

The MLK and Magnolia Avenue intersection has been temporarily reopened, as crews continue with Phase II, which is the work from Magnolia Avenue south to Orange Avenue. The six-inch reclaimed and sewer pipes are being installed from Magnolia Avenue to Orange Avenue. Once the piping is in, it will need to be tested before the excavation area can be restored and the new piping can be used.

All businesses along MLK are accessible to pedestrians. The area has signage for the detours around the area, as well as signs for the businesses. Businesses are accessible through the side streets around the area. Customers of businesses in the area can park temporarily in the right-of-way on the side streets. Pedestrians should not walk through the work area. If walking around the work site perimeter, pedestrians are urged to use caution.
