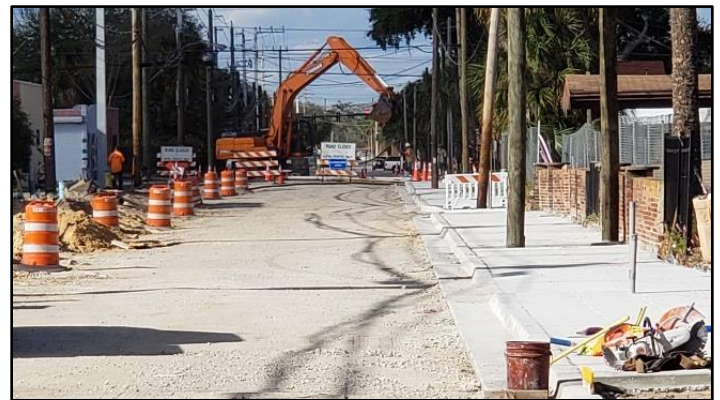


**Orange Avenue to Magnolia Avenue  
reopened to local traffic**

**Sidewalk installation continues on east side of roadway**



Over the holidays, crews were able to reopen the roadway from Orange Avenue to Magnolia Avenue to local traffic. Sidewalk installation is continuing on the east side of the roadway from Orange Avenue to Magnolia Avenue. The new sidewalk is 8-feet wide, compared to the old sidewalk, which was 4 to 6-feet wide. The new pedestrian-friendly surface features a decorative window pane pattern and when installation is complete, it will be fully ADA compliant. It will take several weeks for the concrete to cure, so pedestrians in the area should be careful using the sidewalk.

Crews are back in the Magnolia Avenue and MLK intersection this week to connect piping that will be installed north of the intersection. Once the pipe is connected, the road will be closed from Magnolia Avenue to Foote Court as the contractor installs the sanitary sewer and then the new reuse pipe system. The new water main has been installed from Magnolia Avenue to ISB.

All businesses along MLK are accessible to pedestrians. The area has detour signage, as well as signs for all businesses. Customers can park temporarily in the right-of-way on the side streets. Pedestrians should not walk through the work area. If walking around the work site perimeter, pedestrians are urged to use caution.
