

**Water services tied in  
from Orange Avenue to  
Magnolia Avenue**

**Work continues from Magnolia Avenue to ISB**



Next week crews will be tying in the reclaimed service and water services from Orange Avenue to Magnolia Avenue and on Cherry Street. Once the project is complete, all of the residents and businesses in the project area will have access to reclaimed water. City staff plan to begin installing the new water service lines and meter boxes for each property between Orange Avenue and Magnolia Avenue beginning Wednesday, Jan. 22. Staff are contacting each property owner to coordinate the installation. As part of the installation, there will be a short interruption of water services so staff will coordinate to minimize the impact of interruptions. Next week crews will start installing new pipe from Foote Court to International Speedway Boulevard. All of the electrical junction boxes for the new streetlight poles have been installed from Orange Avenue to Magnolia Avenue.

Businesses on MLK remain open as road improvements continue between Orange Avenue and International Speedway Boulevard. The area has detour signage, as well as signs for all businesses in the area. Customers can park temporarily in the right-of-way on the side streets to access the businesses. Pedestrians should not walk through the work area. If walking around the work site perimeter, pedestrians are urged to use caution.
