

RESOLUTION NO. 19-30

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 TO ASSIST IN THE COST OF FLORIDA'S BICYCLE PEDESTRIAN FOCUSED INITIATIVE PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN FURTHERANCE OF THE GRANT APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City desires to implement an initiative project to focus on high visibility enforcement in an effort to reduce pedestrian and bicycle deaths or serious injuries (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for the Project is \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, grant funds are available from Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT"), as administered by the University of South Florida and the University of North Florida, to defray the Project's cost; and

WHEREAS, FDOT does not require a matching fund commitment as a condition of applying for or accepting the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief recommends acceptance of the grant and execution of the Grant Agreement.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to submit an application to the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") on behalf of the City for grant funds in an amount of \$30,000, to defray the cost of the Florida's Bicycle Pedestrian Focused Initiative project referenced above.


SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to accept the grant referenced above, and execute the Grant Agreement, a copy of the Agreement in substantially final form being attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 3. The Budget Officer is hereby directed to amend the current year's Fiscal Year Revenue and Expense Budget in accordance with the grant funds authorized by this Resolution; to carry forward unexpended budgeted grant funded expenditures, budgeted matching funds, and budgeted unearned grant revenues from fiscal year to fiscal year throughout the term of the grant; to adjust the budgeted grant funded expenditures and unearned revenues for program revenues, minor changes in the grant agreement, and accounting adjustments; to (where applicable) reduce budgeted matching funds based upon amendments to the grant agreement; and to close out unexpended budgeted grant expenditures and unearned budgeted grant revenues upon the expiration of the grant.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
