

RESOLUTION NO. 19-222

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA, OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT PROGRAM, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$48,467.00 FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S VICTIM'S ADVOCATE PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING A MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,116.00; AUTHORIZING USE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUNDS FOR THE MATCH; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN FURTHERANCE OF THE GRANT APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE; AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT OF THE BUDGET IF THE GRANT FUNDS ARE AWARDED; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF ALL FUNDS AWARDED PLUS THE MATCHING FUNDS FOR CONTINUATION OF THE VICTIM'S ADVOCATE PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Office of the Attorney General, Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Program, has grant funds available to fund victim assistance programs; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief recommends the City submit an application for VOCA Program grant funds in the amount of \$48,467.00 for continuation of the Police Department's Victim's Advocate Program, and that the grant funds be accepted, if awarded; and

WHEREAS, the program requires a match from the City, and the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate for the required match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby authorizes submission of a grant application to and acceptance of grant funds from the State of Florida, Office of the Attorney General, Victims of Crime Act Program, in the amount of \$48,467.00 to continue the Police Department's Victim's Advocate Program. A copy of the grant Application in substantially final form is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference

SECTION 2. Matching funds from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund in the amount of \$12,116.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents in furtherance of the grant application and acceptance.

SECTION 4. The Budget Officer is hereby directed to amend the applicable Fiscal Year Revenue and Expense Budget in accordance with the grant funds and matching funds authorized by this resolution; to carry forward unexpended budgeted grant funded expenditures, budgeted matching funds, and budgeted unearned grant revenues from fiscal year to fiscal year throughout the term of the grant; to adjust the budgeted grant funded expenditures and unearned revenues for program revenues, minor changes in the grant agreement, and accounting adjustments; to reduce budgeted matching funds based upon amendments to the grant agreement; and to close out unexpended budgeted grant expenditures and unearned budgeted grant revenues upon the expiration of the grant.


SECTION 5. Expenditure of all grant funds plus matching funds in the total amount of \$60,584.00 for continuation of the Police Department's Victim's Advocate Program is hereby approved.

SECTION 6. In accordance with the requirement of § 932.7055(5)(b), Florida Statutes, the City Commission acknowledges receipt of the request and written certification of the Police Chief that the request complies with the provisions § 932.7055, and hereby authorizes the expenditure of law enforcement trust funds for this purpose.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
