

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-121

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, AMENDING THE HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH FDOT TO REMOVE SLOPE MOWING SERVICES FROM THE ACTIVE CONTRACT AND TO REDUCE THE CONTRACT PRICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,516; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT OF THE APPLICABLE FISCAL YEAR REVENUE AND EXPENSE BUDGET; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 16-149, the City Commission approved a Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), providing for City routine maintenance of certain state Rights-of-Way within the corporate city limits of the City of Daytona Beach, for a three-year period with one three-year option to renew for an annual payment from FDOT in the amount of \$267,014.28 (Contract No. ARY46); and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 19-81, the City Commission authorized renewal of the Agreement with FDOT for an additional three-year Term; and

WHEREAS, Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Memorandum of Agreement has been prepared, to remove Slope Mowing services from the active contract and FDOT would reduce payment to the City in the amount of \$8,516, through the end of the renewal Term; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director recommends approval of the amendment.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The State of Florida Department of Transportation Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with FDOT is hereby approved. The Supplemental Agreement amends the Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (Contract No. ARY46-R1) between the City and FDOT, by removing the Slope Mowing services from the active contract and reducing the contract price in the amount of \$8,516 to be paid by FDOT to the City.


SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with FDOT, a copy of the Agreement in substantially final form being attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 3. The Budget Officer is hereby authorized to amend the applicable fiscal year revenue and expense budgets in accordance with the Supplemental Agreement No 1.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
