



Fats, Oil, and Grease (FOG) Program

Welcome! Thank you for locating your business within the City of Daytona Beach. We are excited to work with you and hope that together we can make your business a success. The City is committed to providing safe, cost-effective wastewater service to our commercial and residential customers within our city. We are equally dedicated to operating our wastewater system in an environmentally responsible manner.



In accordance with the Land Development Code Article 7, Section 2p.10. The City of Daytona Beach would like your cooperation and participation in our EPA mandated Fats, Oil, and Grease (FOG) Program. The purpose of this program is to regulate (FOG) discharged by Food Service Establishments (FSE) and other FOG producing businesses. Wastewater discharges containing high concentrations of (FOG) significantly contribute to preventable blockages or overflows from the City's wastewater collection system.



All potential FOG producing entities in the City of Daytona Beach are required to apply for a discharge permit. There is **no charge** for the discharge permit, and it is effective for five (5) years from the date of issue. A discharge permit application is attached to aid in determining if a permit is required for your entity. If it is determined that your entity does produce FOG, you are required to follow the policies and procedures set within the Cities FOG manual. If you do not already have an existing FOG device, such as a grease interceptor, grease trap or separator, installation of one may be required.



The City of Daytona Beach would also like to introduce its newest Fats, Oils, and Grease platform. FOG BMP is being provided **free** by the City to help you easily ensure that your facility stays in compliance with the City's rules and regulations. This new platform will aide in pump out reminders, finding certified waste haulers, inspection information as well as Best Management Practices, training videos and even kitchen signage. It also allows you to make changes or updates to your facilities information at any time. We encourage your business to give it a try. Just simply provide an email address and instructions will be sent with a link.



Your urgency and cooperation with this matter is greatly appreciated. Please complete the enclosed discharge permit application and return it via email or US postal service. Failure by an existing entity to comply could result in further action per Article 10 of the Land Development Code for the City of Daytona Beach.
