New work may begin before the permits are issued, but shall not be concealed and must remain open for all necessary inspections. At the time of inspections, any concealed work must be uncovered. Inspections of work for any construction trade will not be made until a permit has been issued for the trade.

The Early Start Authorization does not guarantee that the construction plans will be approved as submitted. All work done prior to issuance of the required permits shall be at the general contractor's and the trade contractor's risk. The City of Daytona Beach and the Permit & Licensing Division will not be held liable for any damages or losses resulting from the work authorized herein and the general contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of Daytona Beach and the Permit & Licensing Division from any and all damages, losses, or liability resulting from such work.

Failure to comply may constitute a violation of the City of Daytona Beach Land Development Code
